DIVISION I: FLOWER DESIGN

- ◆ Any flowers or plant material used shall be fresh (except Division I, Classes 9). No wires are permitted above the water line. No artificial coloring allowed.
- ◆ A list of plant material used in the Flower Design Division *must* accompany the entry.
- ◆ **ONLY** 1 entry per person in each class.
- ◆ Flowers on the endangered list are not allowed. Endangered list is available from the state.
- ◆ Extra points will be awarded to those that incorporate **Home Sweet Home** into their design.
- ◆ Premiums for the Flower Design Division are as follows:
1st prize: \$5.00 2nd Prize: \$3.00 3rd Prize: \$2.00

Division I Classes

Class 1: Mixed centerpiece

Class 2: A-tiskit, a-tasket, a flowering basket (not to exceed 16" in any direction)

Class 3: Arrangement of Wild Flowers

Class 4: Arrangement of Garden Flowers

Class 5: Wreath or Wall Design (no more than 12" deep and no larger than a 30" outside diameter)

Class 6: Small Treasures- A small design not to exceed 8" in any direction

Class 7: Dried Flower Arrangement for a mantle (not to exceed 12" deep, 24" wide and 24" tall)

Class 8: A Walk in the Woods- A design incorporating branches and weathered wood not to exceed 24" in any direction

DIVISION II: HORTICULTURE

- “ Any flowers or plant material used shall be grown by the exhibitor for at least 8 weeks. no wires permitted above the water line. no artificial coloring allowed.
- “ only 1 entry per person in each class.
- “ each entry should be only 1-3 stems, with no leaves below the water line.
- “ exhibitors must furnish their own clear see-through container. no beer cans, wine or soda bottles.
- “ premiums for the horticulture division are as follows:
1st prize: \$3.00 2nd prize: \$2.00 3rd prize: \$1.00
