All Maple Syrup entries require one-pint containers; all other classes are to be in the quantity indicated. All syrup entries must be graded by the entrant.

Class and Product:

1. Maple Syrup, Vermont Fancy
2. Maple Syrup, Vermont Medium Amber
3. Maple Syrup, Vermont Dark Amber
4. Maple Syrup, Vermont Grade B
5. Pure Maple Sugar Cakes, 5 Small
6. Pure Maple Cream, 8 ounces in glass container
7. Pure Maple Fudge, 8 ounces
8. Pure Maple Granulated Sugar, 8 ounces in glass container

Only one entry allowed in each class per farm, sugar maker or individual. Violation of this rule shall result in disqualification. All entries shall become property of the Franklin County Sugar makers. Judging of syrup will be done on density, color, clarity and flavor by Vermont Department of Agriculture judges; their decision will be final. Rejected entries - entrant will be notified of the reason by judges. Each excellent entry shall receive \$6.00 premium from

Franklin County Sugar makers and \$6.00 matched by Field Days. Best of Class in each category shall receive \$10.00 from the Sugar makers, provided there is more than one excellent entry in the category. Best of Show shall receive \$25.00 from the Sugar makers. Best Fancy Maple Syrup shall receive the Cleon Gillilan award of \$50.00 from the Franklin County Sugarmakers.

Entries accepted Thursday, July 30, 2009 from 9 A.M. to 12 noon at the sugarhouse.
