

# Franklin County Fair & Field Days Demo Rules

## Bone Stock Compact Rules – 2026

### Competition Rules:

1. Drivers must remain in the vehicle with helmet, seatbelt, eye protection and steering wheel on until notified by an official that it is safe to exit the car. Long sleeves and pants are required; fire proof clothing is suggested.
2. Driver only in tech line if you have multiple vehicles have a crew member bring up car together or bring it up after yourself.
3. Tech closes 1 hour before show time. Do not wait to come to tech. You will not get a chance to fix anything that is wrong.
4. Driver door hits are illegal. If the hit is deemed by an official to be careless or intentional, you will be disqualified. If you use your driver's door as a defense, we will not enforce the rule.
5. NO hot rodding in the pits. Keep it at an idle.
6. Any open door will be cause for disqualification. Broken seat will cause for disqualification.
7. You are allowed one fire. A second fire will be cause for disqualification. You may return in later rounds.
8. Sandbagging is not tolerated and will be strictly enforced. Locking up brakes prior to a hit for anything other than a drivers door hit will be cause for disqualification. The fans pay to see a show, put one on for them.
9. No teaming this will cause for disqualification.
10. You must make an aggressive hit every 60 seconds.
11. There is absolutely NO alcohol in the pits. This includes pit crews. If you or your crew is caught with alcohol, you will be disqualified. Addison County Fair & Field Days has a NO alcohol policy.

### General:

1. No Imperials 1973 or older or imperial sub frames
  - a. No Hearses or ambulances
  - b. No trucks or truck frames
  - c. Any questions on car choice please ask
2. All cars must have a number or slogan displayed on each side of the vehicle large enough for the Announcer to read, a roof sign is also highly recommended. No profanity or vulgar sayings. We have also been requested by our Fair Boards to do away with middle finger flappers on the headers.
3. Stock means stock all cars are considered stock except anything specified in these rules. All rust and rot repair must be OK'd by head official.
4. This class is open to any FWD or RWD V6, or 4-Cylinder car. (Other than what is listed above).
5. Cars must be stripped prior to showing up to the event, air bags must be removed all flammable materials be removed.

6. No Welding. Four wires or chains per door. Four wire or chain hold-down's locations for hood. Four wire or chain hold-down locations for trunks. No additional material may be added. 9 wire can be double strands and chain can be no bigger than 3/8. No combinations of the 2.
7. Move the battery to the passenger side floorboard or front seat area. No milk crates, no zip ties, no zip screws can be used. Metal battery box, bolted to the floor.
8. Move the gas tank if it is mounted behind the rear axle, if in front of the rear axle and safe it can remain in the stock location.
9. Stock or aftermarket shifter allowed.
10. Any air-filled DOT tires are allowed, no doubled tires!
11. No aftermarket parts other than what's listed.
12. Any oem bumper is allowed or a piece of no larger than 3x3 1/4 wall square tubing. Bumpers must be no wider than center of tire to center of tire, oem bumpers may be seam welded but the ends must remain open for inspection, 3x3 bumpers must remain open on the ends as well. You can weld the bumper on the car using no more than a 6x6 1/4 inch plate welded to the end of the frame for mounting purposes only, all welds are to be single pass, No stacking welds.
13. No suspension modifications.
14. Stock steering column. NO aftermarket column.
15. NO body creasing. Quarters must remain vertical on fresh and pre-run. Do NOT wedge the back. Speaker deck must remain in stock location, DO NOT remove it. Pre-ran cars will have to pull quarters up if pushed down.
16. NO TUCKING
17. NO added Bumper shocks.
18. Headers will be allowed.

These are bone stock rules, bone stock means bone stock, the rules are black and white NO GRAY areas. Build to what's written or be prepared to cut!
