- Exhibitor must be a Franklin County resident 18 years of age and older to enter exhibits
- Items must be completed in the last 12 months by the person whose name is on the entry.
- No name may be visible on the entry item itself.
- Only one item may be entered per class. Any item that fits into a listed class may not be put in another class.
- Entries must be left on display until 5:15PM on Sunday (no exceptions). Premiums will be given out at this time according to the following ribbons. Please make sure you or a designated person picks up entries by 5:30 latest. It has been a long week, thanks for your consideration.
